School Profile by CHAPITA PRIMARY SCHOOL



Chapita Primary School was established on 7th July 1997. Our school is along the lakeshore road. It is about 15 kilometres south of Salima District.

Chapita has standards 1-8 with an enrolment of 781 learners of which 406 are girls while 375 are boys.



The age range of the school is 6-17 instead of the normal 6-14. This is so as a result of either repeating classes when one fails end of year exams or the learners starting school at a later stage.

Chapita has 11 teachers (5 male and 6 female).

Mr Isaac Zatha is the head teacher while Mr Dalitso Madondolo is the link coordinator.
